Children's Centre and Youth Club-

The proposal is to shut the Children's Centre AND the Youth Club and deliver both the services from a neighbourhood hub in the library. The current library is the wrong place for this although we support the closure of the Children's Centre building at the Civic Hall.

The Library is not big enough, does not have enough flexible secure and private meeting space and is poorly located in relation to the centre of town. The same points are relevant to the proposed relocation of the Youth service.

The current Youth Service building, known to most of us as The Youth Club is the best place for both services to be delivered from. It is centrally located, safe, has relatively anonymous access, has sessional and flexible meeting space and could accommodate a modified library service too.
